As part of the 'Stop that Oil' scheme, Oil users are encouraged to discuss security fears with their local safer neighbourhood team and they will be provided with crime prevention advice and a list of participating oil installers, who will be happy to provide and install an alarm.

Please report any suspicious incidents by calling Dorset Police on 101. In an emergency or if a crime is in progress dial 999.

Be aware that roads are now busier with lots of visitors to the area. Always keep an eye on the speed limit and the conditions of the roads.

It is likely that now that the summer is here and the days are longer the potential for persons driving whilst tired is at a high, 'Driving while tired is extremely dangerous, both for yourself and other road users. Driving requires intense concentration and perception, but these are greatly reduced when you are drowsy. Your judgement skills are also impaired, which can make you slower to see potential or actual dangers and react to them. The law takes a dim view of drowsy driving. If you are caught driving while drowsy or you fall asleep at the wheel, you can be charged with careless or dangerous driving. If you are involved in a fatal accident, you can be charged with dangerous driving. This can result in a prison sentence of up to fourteen years.'
