Remembered with Honour

Frederick Berthold Burge was born in 1920 in Chideock, Dorset. He was the son of Francis Joseph Burge and Ella May Burge (nee White). Francis Burge was a Butcher by trade. Francis and Ella May were married October 12th 1919 in Chideock. He also had an older brother Jack Burge. He attended the Roman Catholic school in Chideock and is present in the 1930 school photograph.

Out the outbreak of war Frederick enlisted in the Dorset Regiment but was later transferred to the Leicestershire Regiment. He died whilst serving with the Army of Occupation after Germany had surrendered.

He is buried at Klagenfurt War Cemetery, Carinthia in Austria. Frederick Burge is commemorated on the Chideock War Memorial.
