GEOFFREY HAROLD STEVENS

Commissioned Gunner on H.M.S. Aurora who died on 30th October 1943 aged 38

Remembered with Honour Portsmouth Naval Memorial.

Goefrrey Harold Stevens was born in Morcombelake in the parish of Whitchurch Canonicorum in 1904. His parents were John Ernest Stevens (1866-1931) and Margaret Jane (nee Larcombe 1870 – 1957). In 2011 Cenus Geoffrey was 6 years old and the occupation of his father was Assistant Overseer (Own Account) and Egg & Poultry Dealer. Geoffrey married to Freda Clara (nee Kingley-Jupp) in September 1930. Geoffrey Stevens was killed during bombing of the Aurora on 30th October 1943. Probate was granted to his widow Freda Clara Stevens at Elson Road, Gosport, Hants.





Geoffrey Harold Stevens is remembered on the family grave in the Chideock Cemetery and commemorated on the Chideock War Memorial.

John Stevens and his wife Margaret lost two sons in WW2 – Arthur William died 8th August 1943 and Geoffrey Harold was killed in action of 30th October 1943.
